At approximately 75% completion of your book, bring about another noteworthy supernatural occurrence.

This could include a frightening encounter with an angry ghost, a crucial discovery about the origin of the haunting, or a suspenseful psychic showdown. This particular aspect contributes to the increasing suspense leading up to the story's climax.

6. *Third Plot*

In paranormal fiction like [The Armour of Light Book Online](#), the third plot is where the supernatural conflict reaches its peak.
