The Teen Process (Under 18)

2. **The Permit:** At 15 ½, they can take the written knowledge test to get a provisional permit.
3. **Behind-the-Wheel:** This is where Top Drive Driving School comes in. The law requires 6 hours of professional training. The first lesson must be taken to validate the permit. You cannot legally drive with parents until an instructor signs your permit.
4. **Practice:** Teens need 50 hours of practice with an adult (10 at night).
